#### **Hats and Sunscreen**

All children need to wear hats in Term 1 and Term 4. We also encourage children to have sunscreen applied at home and we provide sunscreen in all of our classrooms and children will reapply during the day.

We have a very simple rule around sun safety. **No hat = no play** and these children need to be under the shade sails during breaks. School hats are available to purchase from the school office. They are \$15. All children need to be wearing the black school labelled hat only.

# Covid/ CPF update

Firstly, many thanks. The way everyone has followed our new guidelines is really pleasing and very much appreciated by us all. Our tamariki have done a wonderful job adjusting to masks and they are outside regularly under the new timetable, so there is plenty of mask off time.

#### What's ahead -

- 1. On Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> February we will be sending home two documents via the eldest child in the family. One is the contact details we hold for you. This will be in a sealed envelope. If you don't want this sent home this way, please ring the office on Tuesday morning. It's CRITICAL this information is correct, so please change any details and return by Friday 11<sup>th</sup> February. The second will be an agreement in the event your child or your child's class is isolating at home. We have devices (ipad or chromebook) ready to be sent home should this be the case. We need the form completed now to allow this to happen. Please complete and return to school by Friday 11<sup>th</sup> February.
- 2. Next week we will be sending an update (via the app and email) to you all. This will contain how school will operate once we have cases in our school and community. I know I keep saying it...but please make sure you have the app and update us with your current email. These communication tools are critical.

### Mahora School Sports Newsletter





Most of the Term 1 Sports were listed in an App message earlier this week, along with playing days, venue and cost. There is just an Athletics option added today. This newsletter has some additional general sport guidelines plus the forms for you to fill out and return to school. These need to be returned to school by NEXT WEDNESDAY 9<sup>th</sup> FEBRUARY please. A number of sports have limited team entries this term due to current number restrictions so please message me if your form is not back in time, if your child is keen to join one of these sports. I can only accept late entries if there is space in a team. All of the sports listed are for both girls and boys.

The School is required to pay the entry fee when teams are registered so payment for each sport is due when your notices are returned. We understand that this is an expensive time of year, so we are happy for families to set up an automatic payment to pay off sport fees. Fees outstanding from 2021 must be paid or an automatic payment set up before your child can participate in a sports team this year.

Once a commitment has been made to a team, it is expected students will remain in the team for the term. They may also have a practice commitment but these are likely to be in school time.

Some teams will have teacher coaches but to offer the wide variety of sports that we do, we are reliant on our wonderful volunteer parent or other whānau coaches to support some of the teams. To align with Ministry of Education guidelines, all whānau who take on a coaching role or a managing role, sideline with our tamariki will need to be fully vaccinated against COVID 19 and be willing to send a copy through to Kirsten, kirstenw@mahora.school.nz or Rohan, principal@mahora.school.nz I will ensure all equipment, uniforms and draws are organised for every team and that coaches receive support and training for the coaching role if required. Please consider coaching a team this year.

Teams for each of our sports will only be entered if there are enough interested students and coaches available.

<u>Transport</u> Generally it is your responsibility as parents to organise transport to the different sports. However we do have parents and staff that are often happy to assist so please let us know if you are stuck.


