Term 3

Our term has started well and we look forward to a settled 'normal' term ahead...well fingers crossed. Thanks so much to everyone for the efforts in the first half of the year, it was certainly an interesting time. There are a few reminders and updates below in relation to the term ahead and general information.

<u>Building Development</u> – It is fantastic to see this fully up and running again. You will notice the new walkthrough is taking shape quickly. This has been a long time in the planning so it is great to see progress. The end result will see much improved access around the school. In the meantime, please use the side of Room 1-4 for access and be aware the ground is quite uneven in this area.



<u>Staff Only Day</u> – All schools in NZ have a number of staff only days to use to support curriculum development over two years. These days mean the school will be closed so staff can be involved in development. Due to the year we have had, we held off using any of these in the first part of 2020. The Board have approved two days for the second half of this year and these are listed below. We hope you can make it a long weekend or use the time as a family.

<u>Covid 19</u> – Many thanks for your feedback about the school procedures. Please continue to support the current level 1 guidelines in place. It is great to see independence continuing to develop with children walking in by themselves. It's also been great to see parents coming and spending time in classes and connecting on a Friday. If this day doesn't suit you then please know you are welcome any time. We have continued with split lunch times this term. This is due to us having very limited court space with building development and the wet weather causing the fields to be closed. We simply can't fit on the court areas if the field is out of action. We hope to have a solution to share with you around this in the near future. Eating after the breaks continues to work well and from what we see children are eating more!!
