We are asking that all whānau access the Doc (we can send a paper copy home if you cannot access it electronically) and start to discuss and fill in the <u>first page</u> with your children. It is important that we have your voice, as well as your child's on this document.

Teachers are starting to work on Page 1 and Page 3 of the document, and will continue to update these, along with Page 2 over the coming weeks.

Next week there will be another video on the website around what Page 2 of the Piki Haere Doc will contain. It will be around assessment and progress information.
