Enrolments

This is the first time we have no one to introduce, as we have enrolled all our students for the year. If you have children you are enrolling for 2022, please do this before the end of the school year to ensure we know they will be here.

End of Year 2021

We will start sharing some of this information now, but there will be more details in a following newsletter. It will be slightly different to previous years given the Covid 19 situation.

Lost Property

We have lots of lost property. This year we will display this in a coned off area opposite Room 1. Parents can access this from the footpath as the sliding gate will be open from 2.30pm - 3.15pm, Monday - Wednesday next week. Please maintain appropriate distancing, like you are currently doing on the footpath. Please have a look through, if your child has lost any items of clothing. All unclaimed items will be on sold or donated at the end of the year.

<u>Accounts</u>

We all have bills...school included! **We need these paid before the end of the year please**. Our financial year runs from 1st January to 31st December, so really important these are settled. This is particularly important for parents of Y6 students. These have been emailed out to you, so please check your emails.

Prizegiving - Our school prizegiving is on **Monday 13th December** at 6.00pm. Points to note include:

- 1. Unfortunately, as previously stated, parents and whānau will not be able to attend this year. We know this is incredibly hard and feel your frustration as well...it's not how we work and you know this. However, we are responsible for keeping everyone safe and we need to do that in 2021.
- 2. We will be live streaming this event so you will be able to connect. There will be lots and lots of photos taken and shared. More details about the streaming closer to the time.
- 3. <u>ALL</u> Year 5 and 6 Mahora children need to attend this event please. It is a school activity. While the main focus is on Y6's, our Y5's will be playing a very important part in this year's event, so we need each of them there please.
- 4. All Year 5's, need to be in school uniform please. Year 6 children wear their smart clothes, as they are our school leavers and will sit separately.
- 5. The Prizegiving is held in our school hall. Year 5 & 6 children will need to be dropped and collected from the front gates only. A staff member will be there to meet them. There is plenty of parking outside. Children need to be here no later than 5.45pm please.

The last day of Term 4 is Thursday 16th December and school finishes at <u>12.00pm</u>.

Start of year 2021

At this stage, we are waiting for the updated education guidelines under the traffic light system to know how school will operate from 2022. This information is due soon to schools, so we will share further guidelines once we have processed the information. This may impact some of the information below (e.g. how to purchase stationery) but we will keep you updated, all with the aim of keeping our community safe. Thanks for supporting and trusting us in this.



Start of school year

Day 1 for the 2022 school year is **Tuesday 1st February**. It is VERY important every child is here day 1 please.

School Donations

Our Board has remained in the Ministry of Education donation scheme. This means there is no donation asked for in 2022.

Stationery

We are continuing with pre-packed stationery packs in 2022. All stationery for Mahora children must be purchased through our school office. We do not make any profit from the stationery, we simply pass the cost on. Pack costs in 2022 will be:

New Entrants (Junior Team)	- \$30 per child
Year 1 & 2 (Junior Team)	- \$25 per child
Year 3 & 4 (Middle Team)	- \$20 per child
Year 5 & 6 (Senior Team)	- \$15 per child

If you would like to pre-pay 2022 stationery now to save the cost at the start of the year, you can pay into the school bank account using your child's name and 'stationery' as a reference, or if you have a credit on your school account please let Kirsten know by emailing her on <u>kirstenw@mahora.school.nz</u>. Your child's name will be recorded and they will be handed their new pack on day 1.

The school office will be open from the following dates. At this stage, we are unsure how this will work and will advise closer to the time, as I know many of you will want to purchase uniform as well.
