COVID-19 Update

A big thanks again to all parents who have followed our school guidelines, your support is really appreciated. There are a few updates to our systems **from Tuesday 2nd June** –

- 1. Our builders are returning to our site and will work in Room 7 & 8, the new breakthrough to the back of school and the deck outside Rooms 1-4 will commence. This is great news and we look forward to this progress.
- 2. Due to the building work re-commencing, the Frederick Street Driveway will be <u>closed</u> until further notice.
- 3. Access to the back or front of the school will revert to around the side of Rooms 1-4. Now that the junior playground has been removed there is plenty of space for children to do this.
- 4. Front Gate children and the Back Gate children will continue to use their allocated gates and at the same times. So, <u>no changes</u> to these groups of children at all. Please make sure your child/ ren continue to use their allocated gate.
- 5. **Back Gate parents** the Duke Street crossing will no longer have people controlling this in the mornings. If you drop your child to the back gate, please be aware and help them to cross safely. There will continue to be a staff member there to greet the students and support with hand sanitiser etc. The road patrollers will be at the crossing in the afternoons.
- 6. **Back Gate parents** We are going to continue to lock the back gate from 8:55am, so please ensure your child is here before that time, otherwise they will need to be dropped off at the front gate.
- 7. **Front Driveway Gate children** will now use the main front gate both in the morning and the afternoon. The afternoon pick up time will remain at 3pm which will mean the group prior would have already left. Please don't arrive before 3pm to avoid any congestion between the two groups. This will allow time for the previous group to depart from 2.45pm.
- 8. All other systems remain as they are. Thank you to parents for not being on site.

If you have any questions about any of this, please contact us. Class teachers have unpacked this with their classes today so all children should know exactly where to go on Tuesday. Please remind them on Tuesday morning given it is a long weekend.
